## Photo Contest Grades 6 thru 12

### Contest Rules:

- Photos should adhere to the theme of **Live Green and Prosper**.
- Photos can be either black & white or color and should be taken in Indiana.
- Photos should be 5" x 7" mounted to a 10" x 12" sheet of construction paper.
- Include a brief typed description (25 words or less) – location, date, subject, type of camera used and a personal experience related to the photo.
- Attach the description to the construction paper under the photo, do not include your name in the description.
- Attach the contest entry form to the back of the poster
- Limit 2 entries per student.

All entries must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2009

Winners will be announced at the Earth Day Indianapolis Celebration, April 25, 2009. Winners are invited, but do not need to be present to win.

There will be **FIVE** winning entries from EACH GRADE LEVEL

1<sup>st</sup> place winners will receive a \$100 gift certificate to be used at any Indiana State Park.

2<sup>nd</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> place winners will receive a \$50 gift certificate to be used at any Indiana State Park.

All winning entries will be displayed at the Children’s Museum in Indianapolis for the month of June and will receive a one year membership to the Indiana Wildlife Federation.
